Bazaar manages these large volumes of collected video for use in operational and intelligence planning, while offering users the means to view, edit, review, and tailor products. To accomplish the significant challenge of storing and accessing this data, ACG has partnered with Pivot3 as the storage backbone.

“Rapid deployment and field-flexibility are key requirements that the Pivot3 clustered storage brings to the project,” said Fred Kleibacker, CEO of ACG Security.
